

The Common Council of the City of Connersville held their regular meeting on Monday, May 5, 2025, at 7:00 P.M. in the Council Chambers at City Hall.

Councilman Jabin Collins led the Pledge of Allegiance and Mary Lou Branson offered an invocation before the start of the meeting.

Mayor Chad Frank presided and called the meeting to order with Councilwoman Jenny Barrett, Councilman Tommy Lee Williams Jr., Councilman Brian Robb, and Councilman Jabin Collins were present. Attorney Geoff Wesling was also present. Councilwoman Sharon McQueen, Councilwoman Diana Phillips, and Councilman Bill Gray were absent.

Councilwoman Phillips made a motion to approve the minutes of the May 5, 2025, regular meeting; Councilman Robb seconded the motion. All Council members voted "yes."

Clerk Treasurer Rosemary Brown requested approval of **Resolution 2025-22**, a resolution transferring Ten Thousand Six Hundred Eighty-One and 50/100 dollars (\$10,681.50) from 2821 Cable Bank Safe to 2501 Cable TV, **Resolution 2025-23**, a resolution transferring Two Hundred Twenty-Nine Thousand Three Hundred Fifty-Nine and 40/100 dollars (\$229,359.40) from 68/22 Utilities Bank Safe to 6101 Water O&M, **Resolution 2025-24**, a resolution transferring Two Hundred Twenty-Nine Thousand Three Hundred Fifty-Nine and 40/100 dollars (\$229,359.40) from 6101 Water O&M to 6824 Water TrustIndiana, and **Resolution 2025-25**, a resolution transferring Fifty Thousand Nine Hundred Sixty-Eight and 75/100 dollars (\$50,968.75) from 2823 General Bank Safe to 1101 General. Councilman Robb made the motion to approve **Resolutions 2025-22, -23, -24 and -25**, Councilman Williams Jr seconded the motion. All Council members voted "yes",

Mayor Frank requested permission to advertise for additional appropriation in the Riverboat Fund for the Transfer Station improvements in the amount of \$274,245.00. Councilman Collins made the motion to approve, Councilman Robb seconded the motion. All Council members voted "yes".

Clerk Treasurer Rosemary Brown requested permission to advertise for additional appropriation for the ARPa fund for Professional Services in the amount of \$20,000.00. Councilman Collins made the motion to approve, Councilman Williams Jr. seconded the motion. All Council members voted "yes".

Mayor Frank stated that there is a budget schedule and SB1 summary in the packet. Please review.


Mayor Frank stated that they will have a public hearing on the fluoride on June 16<sup>th</sup> at 7 pm.
